First Steps:

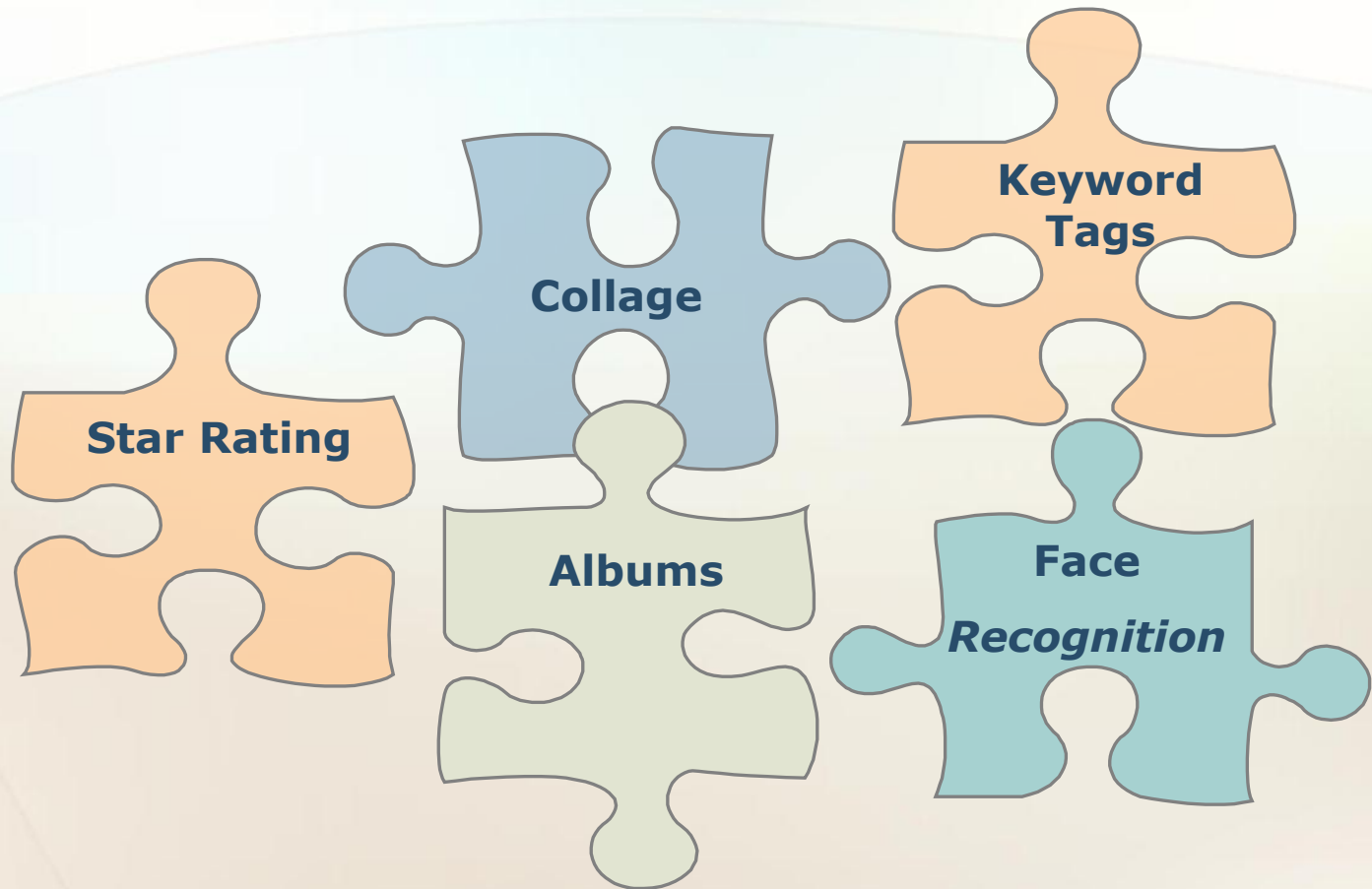
- Decide where to locate new photos
